



Introduction

Welcome to the 15th edition of the *Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) State Options Report.*

This report summarizes 19 SNAP policy options¹ and waivers² SNAP State agencies (50 States, the District of Columbia [DC], Guam, and Virgin Islands) chose in Federal fiscal year (FY) 2023. SNAP's statutes, regulations, and waiver authority provide State agencies with choices on how to administer SNAP. State agencies use this flexibility to adapt their programs to best meet the needs of eligible households with low incomes in their jurisdictions. This flexibility helps State agencies simplify program administration and operations and promote service delivery, tax stewardship, and program integrity.

The Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) and Westat developed this report using extant data from the FY 2023 SNAP State Plans of Operation, SNAP Quality Control State Profiles, and approved waivers.

This report has three parts:

The **Statutory and Regulatory Citations** reference page provides statutory and regulatory citations for each policy option. This page guides the reader to relevant provisions of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 and Title 7 of the Code of Federal Regulations.

Section 1 describes each policy option, the choices within that option, and a map of the State agencies that have selected the option.

Section 2 provides a State-by-State summary of the options each State agency has chosen.





Reporting Requirements

State agencies must assign SNAP households to a reporting system, which dictates the changes in circumstances the household must report to the State agency and when. State agencies may assign different reporting systems to distinct types of households but must do so consistently. Households assigned to change reporting must report certain changes in circumstances within 10 days of the date the change occurs or within 10 days before or after the end of the month in which the change occurs. Households assigned to simplified reporting must report changes periodically and when total countable income rises above 130 percent of the Federal poverty level, when work hours for able-bodied adults without dependents (ABAWDs) fall below 20 hours per week, or when a household receives substantial lottery or gambling winnings.



Certification Periods for Households With Simplified Reporting Requirements

State agencies have flexibility in how long they certify SNAP households assigned to simplified reporting, which is the most common reporting system used. State agencies may certify households in which all adult members are 60 or older or have disabilities for a maximum of 24 months, and all other households for a maximum of 12 months. State agencies must certify households for at least 4 months. Some State agencies certify all households for the same length of time, while others certify households for varying lengths of time. Households certified for longer than 6 months must submit a periodic report 4 to 6 months after certification. Households in which all adult members are 60 or older or have a disability, have no earned income, and are certified for more than 12 months must file a periodic report once a year (State agencies cannot require a periodic report from these household more frequently). This information does not apply to households assigned to other reporting systems, households participating in demonstration projects that may extend certification periods, or households participating in alternative transitional benefits.



Treatment of Self-Employment Income

When determining a household's self-employment income, State agencies must exclude the costs of doing business. State agencies may choose to use actual costs only to calculate the cost of doing business for self-employment income. Or, State agencies may choose to use another method, such as a simplified self-employment expense method FNS has approved, or the standard amount the State agency uses for its Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program.




Standard Utility Allowances

State agencies electing to use Standard Utility Allowances (SUAs) for all households in place of actual utility costs can opt to make their SUA mandatory. If a State agency takes this option, it must not prorate SUAs for households that share living space.

Treatment of Income and Deductions of Ineligible Noncitizens: Pre-PRWORA

Although ineligible noncitizens cannot receive SNAP benefits, their income is considered in determining the eligibility and benefit amount of any other eligible household members. If the noncitizen would have been ineligible for SNAP prior to enactment of PRWORA, State agencies have the following options:

- Count all their income and deductions.
- Count all but a prorated share of their income and deductions.
- Count all their income for the gross income test, and count all but a prorated share of their income for the net income test.

The chosen option must be implemented statewide and applies only to the income of the ineligible noncitizen.



Treatment of Income and Deductions of Ineligible Noncitizens: Post-PRWORA

Although ineligible noncitizens cannot receive SNAP benefits, their income is considered in determining the eligibility and benefit amount for any other eligible household members. If the noncitizen household member is an ineligible noncitizen because of PRWORA, State agencies may count either none or all but a prorated share of the individual's income and deductions. The chosen option must be implemented statewide and only applies to the income of the ineligible noncitizen.



Treatment of Child Support Payments


State agencies have the option to treat legally obligated child support payments made to nonhousehold members as an income exclusion rather than a deduction. This flexibility helps encourage payment of child support by excluding the amount paid from being considered part of the payer's gross income. State agencies that do not use this option treat legally obligated child support payments made to nonhousehold members as a deduction.

Child-Support-Related Disqualifications

State agencies have the option to disqualify from SNAP individuals who fail to cooperate with child support enforcement agencies. Under this option, State agencies may choose to apply the disqualification to custodial parents, noncustodial parents, or both custodial and noncustodial parents. State agencies have the option to disqualify individuals who are in arrears with court-ordered child support payments.



Comparable Disqualifications

State agencies may disqualify from SNAP a household member who fails to perform actions required by certain Federal, State, or local means-tested public assistance programs. State agencies have the option to apply this provision to one or more such programs and may select which disqualifications within a program apply to SNAP recipients. However, SNAP rules set specific limitations. The following are examples of such limitations:

- State agencies may only disqualify the individual who committed the violation, even if the entire household was disqualified under the rules of the other program.
- State agencies may not disqualify an individual for failing to perform a purely procedural requirement.
- State agencies may not disqualify an individual who is not receiving SNAP, including applicants for SNAP.



Drug Felony Disqualifications

Federal law permanently disqualifies from SNAP individuals who are convicted of a Federal or State felony offense involving the possession, use, or distribution of a controlled substance after August 22, 1996. However, Federal law allows State legislatures to opt out of the disqualification or modify the disqualification to impose a less severe restriction. Examples of modified disqualifications include the following:

- Limiting the circumstances in which the permanent disqualification applies (such as only when convictions involve the sale of drugs)
- Requiring the person convicted to submit to drug testing to participate in SNAP
- Requiring participation in a drug treatment program to participate in SNAP
- Imposing a temporary disqualification period



Work Requirements and Disqualification Policy

SNAP household members aged 16-59 must comply with the SNAP general work requirements, which include work registration and a requirement to accept a suitable job if offered, restrictions on voluntarily quitting a job or decreasing hours, and potentially mandatory participation in SNAP Employment and Training or workfare. People are exempt from the general work requirements if they are facing physical or mental barriers to work, caring for a young child or incapacitated person, employed at least 30 hours, or participating in a work program or school halftime or more. Nonexempt individuals who fail to comply, without good cause, are disqualified until they comply, for a minimum of 1 month for the first instance, 3 months for the second, and 6 months for the third. State agencies also have the following options:

- Establish extended disqualification periods of up to 3 months for the first instance, up to 6 months for the second, and date set by the State agency or permanently for the third.
- Disqualify the entire household if the head of household fails to comply (instead of only the head of household).



Voluntary and Mandatory SNAP Employment and Training Programs

State agencies are required to operate SNAP Employment and Training programs (E&T). However, States have significant flexibility concerning the types of programs they offer and the types of SNAP participants they serve. State agencies also have the following options:

- Mandate that certain household members participate in SNAP E&T to maintain their SNAP eligibility.
- Offer SNAP E&T to certain household members on a voluntary basis.
- Mandate E&T participation for certain household members and offer voluntary participation to others.



ABAWD Time Limit Waiver

An able-bodied adult without dependents (ABAWD) is a person who is aged 18-52 who does not meet any of the exemption criteria set by Federal law. People are not considered ABAWDs if they are exempt from the SNAP general work requirements, share a household with a person younger than 18, are pregnant, are experiencing homelessness, are a veteran, or were in foster care at 18 and are still younger than 25. In addition to the SNAP general work requirements, ABAWDs must work and/or participate in a work program at least 80 hours per month, or participate in workfare, to receive SNAP for more than 3 months in a 3-year period. State agencies have the option to request to waive this restriction in areas with an unemployment rate above 10 percent or a lack of sufficient jobs. FNS generally approves waivers for a 12-month period. Implementation periods are not required to align with the Federal fiscal year or quarter, and State agencies may choose to discontinue a waiver prior to its expiration. An ABAWD time limit waiver does not waive the SNAP general work requirements.




ABAWD Discretionary Exemptions

An able-bodied adult without dependents (ABAWD) is a person aged 18-52 who does not meet any of the exemption criteria set by federal law. People are not considered ABAWDs if they are exempt from the SNAP general work requirements, share a household with a person younger than 18, are pregnant, are experiencing homelessness, are a veteran, or were in foster care at 18 and are still younger than 25. In addition to the option to request to waive this restriction, the law provides each State agency with a limited number of discretionary exemptions. State agencies can use these exemptions to extend SNAP eligibility for individual ABAWDs on a monthly basis. Some agencies choose to use discretionary exemptions, while others do not. State agencies with statewide ABAWD waivers do not use discretionary exemptions.


Broad-Based Categorical Eligibility

By law, households that receive cash benefits from another means-tested program such as Supplemental Security Income (SSI), TANF, or General Assistance are categorically eligible for SNAP. In addition, State agencies have the option of adopting broad-based categorical eligibility (BBCE), which expands categorical eligibility to households that receive noncash benefits funded by TANF or Maintenance of Effort funds. Under BBCE, State agencies may align its asset and gross income limits with the TANF noncash benefit program that confers categorical eligibility. BBCE households must meet all other SNAP rules to be eligible.

Transitional Benefits Alternative

State agencies have the option to offer transitional benefits alternative (TBA) SNAP benefits to households leaving TANF or State-funded cash assistance programs. TBA provides households with a set benefit amount and eliminates reporting requirements during the transition period. Benefits can be continued for up to 5 months at a level equal to the amount the household received prior to TANF termination, with adjustments for the loss of TANF income. Certification periods may be extended for households to receive the full 5 months of benefits. 

Demonstrations for Individuals Who Are Elderly and/or Have a Disability

The Elderly Simplified Application Project (ESAP) and the Standard Medical Deduction (SMD) are two SNAP demonstration projects focused on households with adults aged 60 and older and people with disabilities. ESAP streamlines the application and certification process by simplifying the verification process, providing 36-month certifications, and waiving the recertification interview. ESAP serves households that do not have earned income and in which all adult members are aged 60 or older and/or have a disability.

SMD simplifies the excess medical expense deduction by allowing State agencies to establish a standard deduction amount for households that include a person aged 60 or older or a person with a disability. This demonstration project allows State agencies to establish an SMD for these households instead of calculating actual expenses. SNAP households with an adult aged 60 or older and/or a person with a disability are entitled to a deduction from their household income of allowable, out-of-pocket medical expenses the individuals incurred in excess of \$35 a month. The SMD allows agencies to streamline administrative procedures, reduce the paperwork burden on older adults and individuals with disabilities, and simplify the process of claiming this deduction. Households may opt to claim actual medical expenses if they are greater than the SMD.



Combined Application Projects

Combined Application Projects (CAPs) are a partnership of the Social Security Administration (SSA), FNS, and State and local agencies to streamline application procedures for individuals receiving Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits. CAPs are available in two models: standard and modified. The standard model includes simplified joint SNAP/SSI application processing by SSA as individuals apply for or are recertified for SSI. The modified model uses data from SSA to send eligible SSI households simplified SNAP applications. Both models use standard benefit amounts or standard shelter expenses in the benefit calculation and require evaluations to ensure cost neutrality is maintained.


